

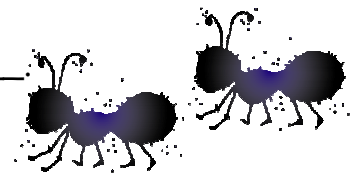
The ants are marching in a row.
