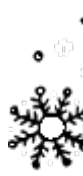

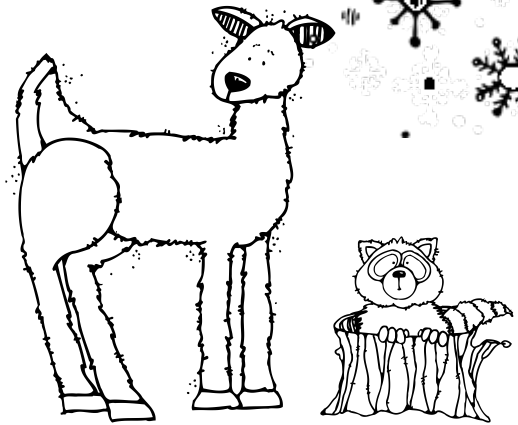

In winter, animals adapt to their environment. Raccoons, squirrels, rabbits, deer and other animals grow a heavier fur coat. Birds grow extra feathers for warmth. Some birds change their bright colors for duller colors for camouflage, so you don't see them as well.

Animals gather and store food. Animals stay in old tree trunks, burrow holes in the ground or dig tunnels in the snow. They make their nests or habitats warmer for the winter by adding leaves, bark, brush or other material.
