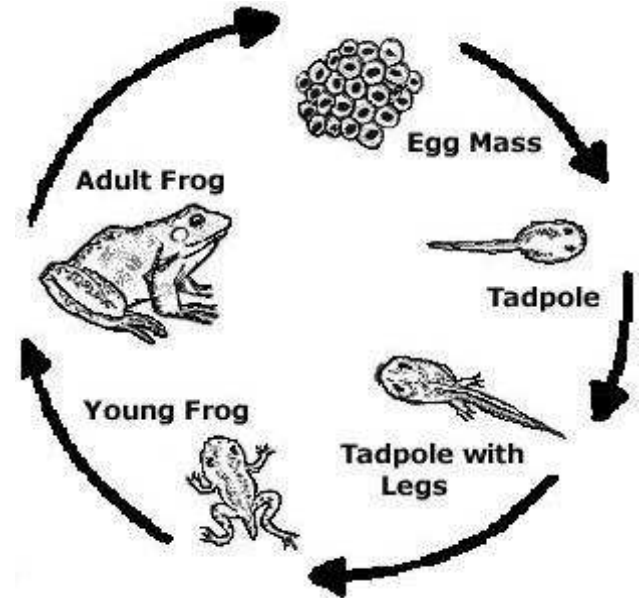
Amphibians are cold-blooded. Their

Directions:

Fold each page in half with the writing to the outside.

Slip the numbered pages in order inside the cover page with the folded edge to the outside or right side of the book. Staple the pages together on the left side. Having the pages folded instead of cut apart makes them sturdier. Also, you can print the cover page on cardstock to make the book last longer. Have students add a picture of their favorite amphibian on the last page.
