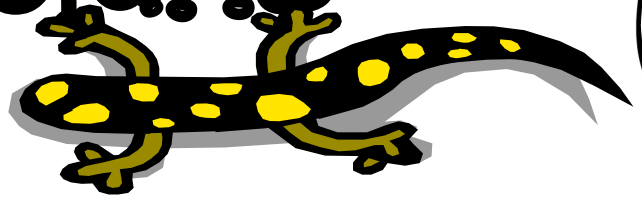
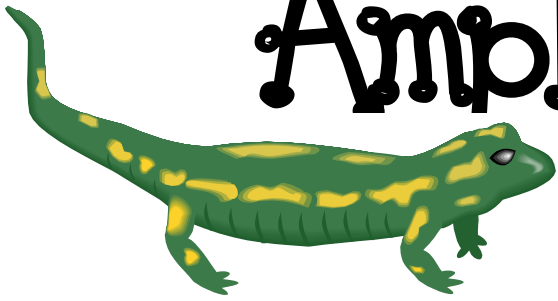


Amphibians
