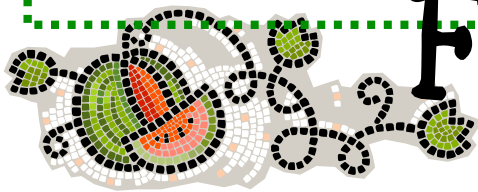


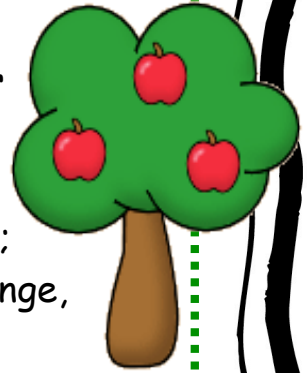
On vines

with delicacies!

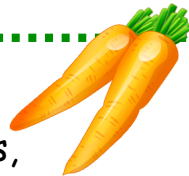


Food's Found
