

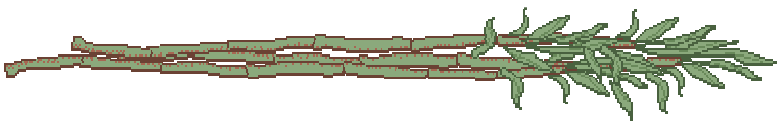
Giant Panda

The giant panda is a rare animal. It is an endangered species which means there are not many living anymore. It lives in the mountains of central China and in some zoos.



It looks like a black and white bear and is now considered to be in the bear family. Giant pandas spend most of their time eating bamboo. They eat sitting in an upright position. When bamboo becomes scarce, they migrate to other areas to find more.

A giant panda weighs under a pound at birth. Its mother carries it around with her everywhere. The babies don't open their eyes for 40 days. The cub stays with its mother for a year and a half.
