Flags



Green Flag

The green flag is waved at the beginning of the race to start the race. It would also be waved to restart the race if needed.

Yellow Flag

The yellow flag is a caution flag. Drivers should slow down immediately because there might be danger ahead.

Black Flag

The black flag is a penalty flag. This means the driver has not followed the rules or used good sportsmanship.

Red Flag

The red flag means that everyone needs to slow down immediately and pull off the track to a safe place.

White Flag

The white flag tells the drivers that there is one lap to go in the race.

Checkered Flag

The checkered flag is waved at the end of the race, first for the winning car and then for the rest of the drivers as they cross the finish line.
