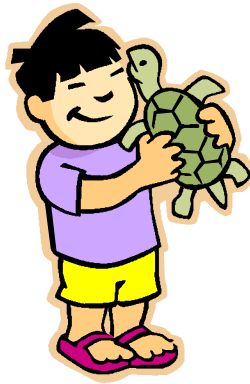

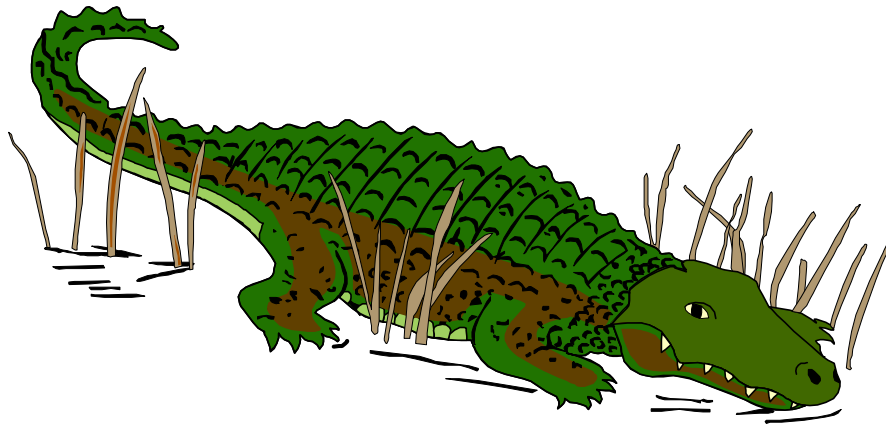

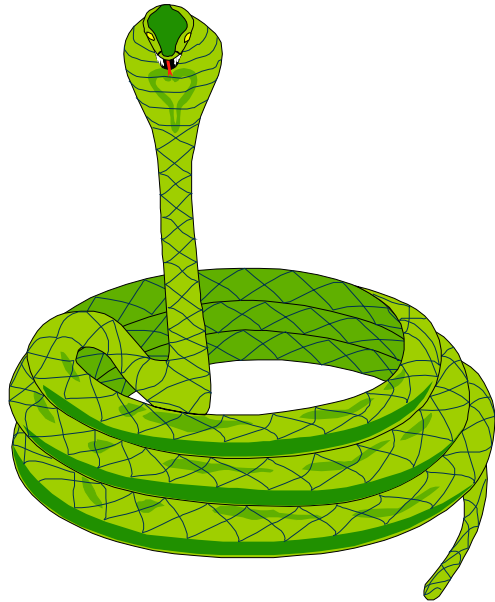
Reptiles are vertebrates.

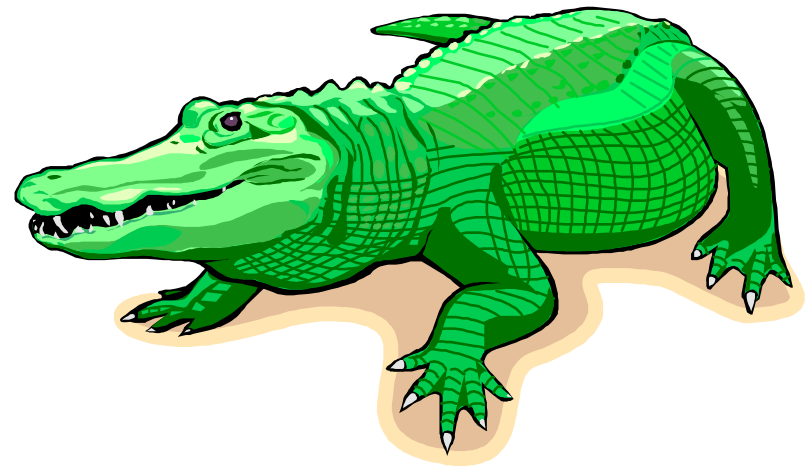
Reptiles are cold-blooded. They

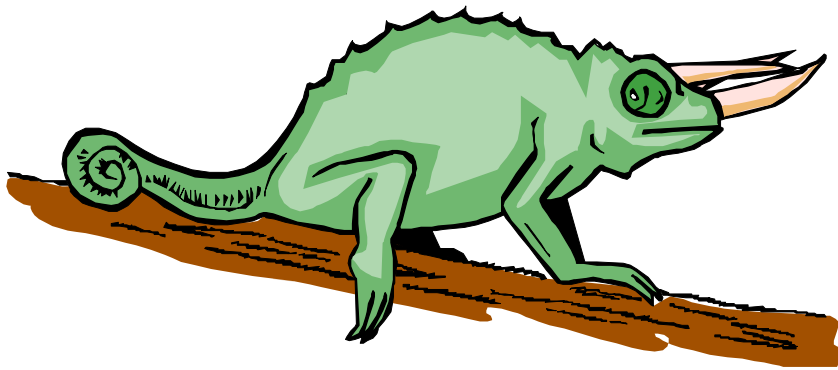
Reptiles have skin covered
