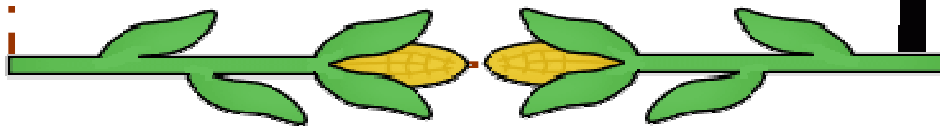
Out in the field in a row of corn,
