A boy builds a snowman and the next morning his hat had slipped, his arms drooped down, and he really looked a fright ~ He begins to wonder:

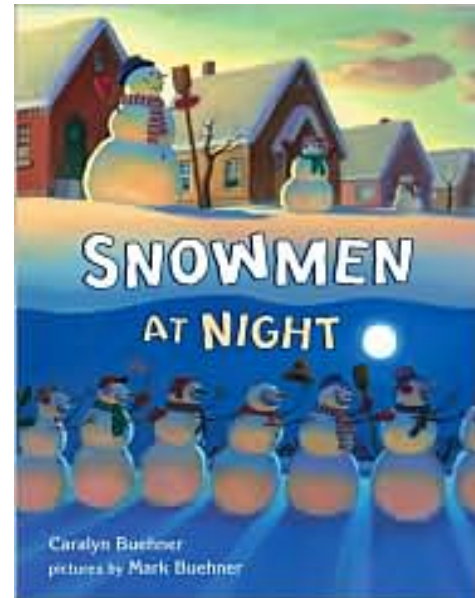
What **do** snowmen do at night?
