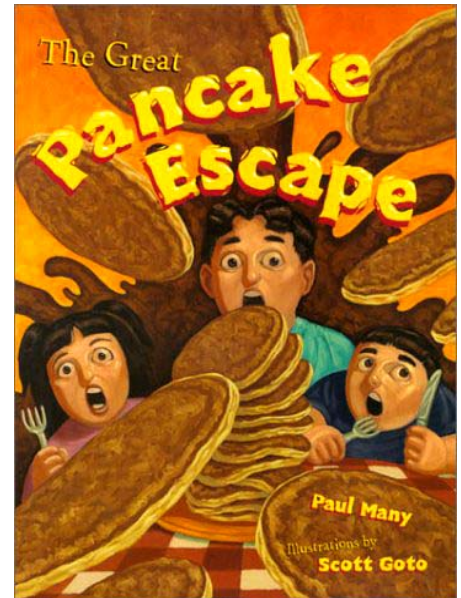


# The Great Pancake Escape!
